Who is Jesus?
The book of Mark reveals who Jesus is, by what He did. In Mark 1: 21-24 people heard Jesus teaching and recognized that He taught with a greater ability and authority than other religious teachers. Even a demon-possessed man identified who Jesus was when he said, "What do you want with us, Jesus? I know who you are – the Holy One of God!"
In Mark 2: 1-12 Jesus was inundated by people seeking healing. A group of men brought their paralyzed friend to Jesus, and instead of praying for him, Jesus said, "Son, your sins are forgiven." The paralysed man stood up and walked in front of everyone.

In Mark 4: 35 – 41 Jesus was in a boat on the lake with His disciples when a storm suddenly arose. The disciples called on Jesus for help, and He rebuked the wind and the waves. Immediately, the wind died down and it was calm.
Jesus' spiritual authority and power was recognized by the natural earthly realm (people and nature) and by the spiritual realm (demons, sickness). By forgiving sins, Jesus claimed to be God, as only God had the power to forgive sin, and these events proved Jesus to be God in human form (Emmanuel – God with us).
