I have seen a 'Have Your Say' property development sign for 13 Vacy Street, Newtown. The plan for the house is to turn it from 1 lot into 2.

I live next door to this house (11 Vacy St), and just from personal experience and seeing how most neighbours have lived in this house, I can say that I would prefer for it to stay as 1 lot. I believe families deserve to have a house with a backyard that they can play in and spend quality time in. Seeing it get split with barely any room for outdoor activities or pets doesn't sit well with me.

Furthermore, the main issue that I have with it becoming two lots is because of our already lack of privacy. I don't know what the potential housing plan is, but the house next door (6 Bristol St) is 2 units and it goes up to two stories. Since it's been built, my family has had serious concerns about our privacy, as the neighbours can look directly into our backyard, our verandah (which is connected by a glass sliding door that leads into the house), our garage and our small shed. We haven't been able to fully open up our blinds or doors/really enjoy our home because of this issue.

I hope you can consider my family's opinion.
